Spring 1
'Claws, Fins and Other Things'

Writing



Children will join in with 'squiggle whilst you wiggle'. This helps children develop their early writing and fine motor skills



Mathematics

Children will continue to recognise groups of objects without counting (subitising 1-3).
Children will also begin to use the mathematical language of size and length.

Physical Development

Children will develop their gross motor skills by climbing and throwing.
Children will also learn how to use scissors safely.



Value of the Half Term

We are Resilient



This half term our value of the term is 'We are Resilient'. Children will learn how to keep going when things feel challenging.



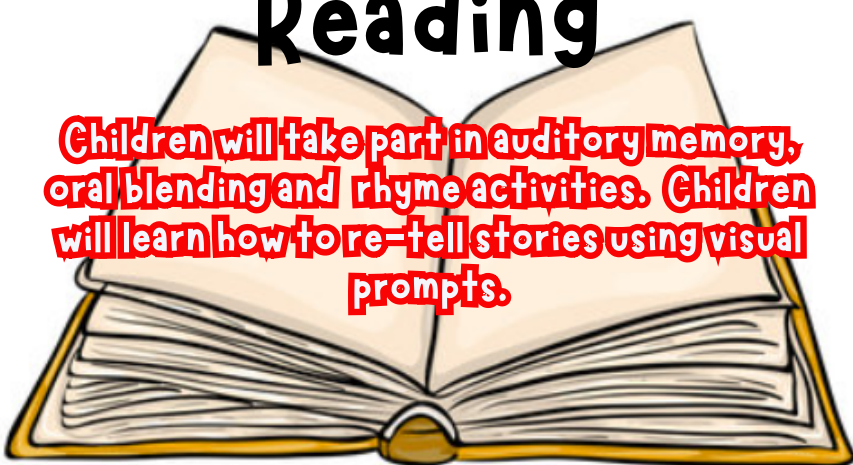
They will explore strategies for staying calm, trying again, and learning from mistakes, recognising that effort and perseverance help them grow.

Understanding the world

Children will learn about materials through hands-on exploration, play, and lots of talk. They will investigate how different objects feel, look, and behave, noticing whether something is rough or smooth, hard or soft, stretchy or rigid. Through sorting, building, water play, and simple experiments, children begin to understand that materials have different properties and purposes.

Reading

Children will take part in auditory memory, oral blending and rhyme activities. Children will learn how to re-tell stories using visual prompts.
