## External Review Celebrates Lee Brigg's Continued Strength!

At the start of February, we welcomed an external review team from Waterton, into school, to evaluate the quality of education, curriculum and leadership across Lee Brigg.

We are delighted to share that the review confirmed Lee Brigg remains a strong, successful and ever-improving school. We are extremely proud of the findings and the recognition our wonderful school deserves.

The report recognised:

- Strong teaching and secure learning across EYFS and KS1
- A well-designed, knowledge-rich curriculum ensuring equality for all pupils
- Strong Early Years provision, with a clear focus on early reading, writing, communication and mathematics
- High-quality support and bespoke provision for pupils with SEND
- Behaviour described as being of the highest standard, with children demonstrating very positive attitudes to learning
- Attendance well above national levels
- Safeguarding firmly embedded in the school's culture

The review described the school as having a joyful climate for learning, with confident pupils who are polite, engaged and proud of their work.

As leaders, we were particularly pleased that the review recognised the daily commitment of all staff to ensure our children receive the very best education. During the review, it was simply a normal day at Lee Brigg – but for our visitors, it was clear that 'our norm' is something truly special.

We are incredibly proud of our children, staff and community for the part they play in making Lee Brigg such a special place to learn and grow.

Our school is thriving, and it is an absolute privilege to lead and serve our school community alongside Miss Kilkenny.
