Learning Overview

This half term we have lots of super exciting learning opportunities coming up! This overview is to give you an insight into what will be happening in the classrooms so that you can discuss this with your child at home.

Powerful Voices

Writing



In writing, children will learn how to write compound sentences, question sentences and exclamation sentences. They will explore different types of punctuation to demarcate their sentences and learn how to use these accurately.

Children will continue to learn how to write different text types.



Mathematics

In maths, children will develop their understanding of place value to one hundred, understanding tens and ones. Year 1 children will practise adding and subtracting one-digit numbers using taught strategies so far. Year 2 children will begin to add and subtract two 2 digit numbers.

Value of the Half Term

We are Kind



This half term our value is 'We are kind'.

In our One Life lessons, we will be focusing on what it means to show compassion. Children will begin by learning about self-compassion, then explore how to show compassion to others, and finally consider how they can demonstrate compassion within the wider world. 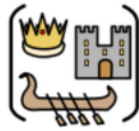

History

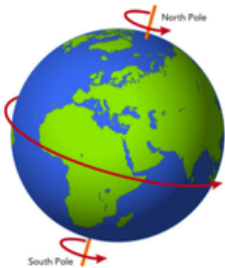


In History, children will learn about Suffragettes and Suffragists, including Emmeline Pankhurst and Florence Beaumont.
