

What's happening in EYFS?



Learning Overview

This half term we have lots of super exciting learning opportunities coming up! This overview is to give you an insight into what will be happening in the classrooms so that you can discuss this with your child at home.

We're going on a Journey!

Writing



In writing this half term, children will continue to focus on accurate and automatic letter formation. Children will practise writing simple CVC words, matched to their phonic knowledge. Some children will begin to write simple captions.



Mathematics

In maths, children will practise subitising numbers up to 5. Children will order numbers up to 10 and begin to count beyond 10. When ready, children will learn about doubles and begin to recall doubles up to 10. Children will also begin to identify patterns in number by sorting numbers into odd and even.

Value of the Half Term

We are Kind!



This half term our value of the term is 'We are Kind'. Children will learn about compassion, what it means and how to show compassion to others. Children will learn different ways to be kind to others and how to support and help others when they find things difficult. Through stories and reflective discussions, children will build confidence in developing skills to be a compassionate friend. They will learn phrases to say to others such as 'It's Ok. I can help you.' Our aim is to help every child develop the skills to be a supportive friend to others.

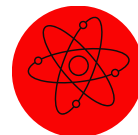


Reading



Children take part in Phonics, Reading Practice and 1:1 reading sessions at school. Don't forget, if they read three times or more a week they get a special sticker and another tick towards their first certificate of the year!

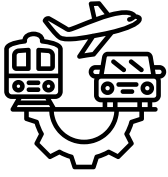


Local walk

Understanding the world



Children will learn about different modes of transport. They will explore transport from the past and the present and compare the similarities and differences.



Children will also learn about Easter and the season Spring.

Oracy

This half term children will further develop their oracy skills.

Children will create their own stories during 'helicopter stories' and perform them to the class. Children will also develop their presenting skills to 'show and tell' special objects to their peers.

Children will learn and perform poems and will re-enact stories using actions and words.



Science



In Science, children will investigate seasonal changes. Children will learn about Spring and compare what they find out to what they know about Autumn and Winter.

Children will also learn about the signs of Spring.



Religious Education

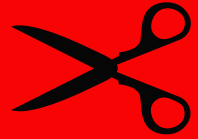
In RE this half term, children will learn about 'who belongs in their family and community'.

Children will explore religious stories about belonging and talk about their family.

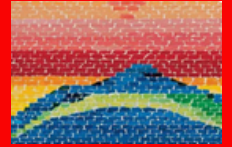
Children will share their own experiences and discuss which communities they belong to and compare these to others.
