<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • feel valued. 	act in a professional manner at all times.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be kept informed. 	<p>communicate with school. Raise concerns or problems that might affect their child's ability to learn or behave appropriately. Notify the school by letter or telephone in the event of absence. Keep us informed of where to contact you in case of emergency.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • expect the best for their children. 	<p>support the school ethos, values and staff. Ensures their child attends regularly, is punctual and ready to learn Support by listening to their child read. Support the school to make sure my child maintains good behaviour. Support the school in getting any help my child may need. Support school in the teaching of safe and secure Internet use at home.</p>
