

Leopard class ideas for home learning:

Reading –

- Read your home reading book and/or other books you may have at least once a day.
- Design a new front cover.
- Write a book review – include title, author, favourite part, picture.

Spellings –

- Learn your spellings for the week and previous spellings sent home.
- Practise ‘the words I need to know’ words in the back of your spelling book.
- Write a sentence including one or two of your spelling words. How many sentences can you write?

Writing –

- Make up another story about Meerkat Mail. This time Sunny goes to a cold place.
- Practise your handwriting (see previous letter formation sheet sent home)
- Practise writing your surname accurately.

Geography –

- Find out about other hot and cold places around the world. What do the people do? What are the houses like? What do they wear? What do they eat?

Maths –

- Practise your number bonds to 10. Can you learn them off by heart?
- Count in 1s, 2s, 5s and 10s to 50 and 100.
- Count forwards and backwards to 100 from any given number.

Art/DT –

- Draw a big cat.
- Make a big cat from recyclable materials.

Computing –

- Log in to Microsoft Word and practise writing using different fonts, sizes, bold, italics, underline and colours

PE –

- Music to dance to (musical bumps/statues)
- Cosmic yoga (see website below)
- Practise throwing and catching a ball or other piece of equipment eg. small teddy
