What a wonderful welly walk we had on Wednesday. We walked to the local woods and the children had a great time squelching through mud and looking at the autumnal changes all around us. We have been discussing what we saw and heard and will be using photos to practise writing words and labels next week. We also painted autumn leaves to practise our colour mixing skills.

We have been reading Billy's Beetles this week and using positional language when finding Billy hiding on the pages or in the classroom. We have also cut out beetles with moving arms and legs and have drawn and labelled our pets (or a pet we would like). In maths we have been learning about comparisons. We have compared groups and learned to use the language: more, fewer (less) and equal (same) to compare quantities. The children enjoyed hunting for autumn objects outside and found leaves, feathers, conkers, acorns and pine cones. If you find any more this weekend, please send them in to add to our collection.

Spots - The children can be 'spotted' for different reasons. Spots are given when children are 'spotted' following our golden rules. This can include trying their best with their learning, using their manners, helping to look after our school (tidying up), thinking and keeping safe (walking and not running inside), listening to others and doing as they are asked by an adult (first time).

Reading books – from next week, your child will be able to change their books on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday only. Please make sure your child has them ready in their hand (books inside the reading record) and puts them in the box when coming into school.
