This week we have continued reading Aliens Love Underpants. The children found alien eggs and a note from the aliens and have been busy writing letters back to them. They have made some rockets and practised the fringing technique needed when joining tubes to boxes. The children have written alien words or practised writing sentences about the story.

In maths the children have been learning their teen numbers. They have learned that the one (first digit) in a teen number represents a group of ten and have matched groups objects to numicon and numerals.

Your child's reading book will be changed at least once a week but please send them in with their book in their hand if it needs changing more frequently.
