



Our sound of the week will be 'a'. Please support your child to bring an object into nursery for our sound table such as an apple or ant. Please remember it is the sound we are learning, therefore, ape and acorn are not correct.

As part of our Investors in Pupils (a programme to recognise, develop and extend pupil voice and participation in schools), we have a class target.
