



**Our sound of the week will be 'p'. Please support your child to bring an object into nursery for our sound table, such as pig or panda. Please remember it is the sound we are learning therefore phone is not correct.**

**Can we please ask that you name the object that you bring in to avoid someone taking the wrong object home?**

**Next week, our key text will be Goldilocks and the Three Bears. To encourage the children to retell the story, we will enhance the home corner with items from the story.**

**Other activities will include baking flapjack, making groups of three objects and comparing, and ordering sizes.**

**We will also sort materials (hard and soft), learn the song 'When Goldilocks went to the house of the bears' and use printing tools to make a picture of a bear.**

**Reminders: Can we please remind you to name your child's clothing (including shoes). Please also remember to provide your child with a pair of wellies if you have not already done so.**
