



In letters and sounds we are going to be sorting objects and remembering the sequence of a selection of objects. These activities help the children with their auditory skills.

The children count daily and sing number rhymes and songs to help them with their number. Next week we will learn Five Cheeky Monkeys and revisit Five Currant Buns.

The children have settled well into nursery life. This week, they have particularly enjoyed Batman Day and Talk like a Pirate Day! They have met Tiger Cub and have learnt about good manners at circle time. Tiger cub watches and listens for children who follow our Golden Rules and rewards the children with golden pebbles.

Next week: Our story of the week will be Little Red Riding Hood and our rhyme of the week will be The Grand Old Duke of York. The children will learn how to mix colours with the paint using the 'Dip, Dab, Dob, Mix' sequence. We will also focus on the children's drawing skills. They will continue to learn their friend's names and to help them with this they will take part in an activity called 'Children Children who do you see?' We are in need of children's umbrellas if anyone has any that they no longer need.
