



In letters and sounds, we will focus on listening and sorting. We will play 'odd one out' and 'phoneme auditory bombardment' (listening for words with the same initial sound such as snake, sausage and sock).

Next week the children will meet Polly (the Nursery puppet) and will begin to plan a party for her. Our key text will be Kipper's Birthday.

The **Christmas Party** will take place on **Friday 20th December.** **All children** will attend nursery from **9am until 12pm** on this day.
