If your child is due to go to school in September, we understand that you may be feeling anxious about their move to school. We are going to do our best to organise some transition days, which will enable the children to meet their new teacher and visit their new classroom. We will also hold a 'new to reception' meeting for parents/carers which will enable you to receive all the information you need about your child starting school.
