


April Challenge

Take a look around your house, your garden or anywhere else you go. What patterns can you make by placing a sheet of paper on things and rubbing a crayon over it?

Some things you could look out for are:

*Bark on trees *Leaves *Pavements, driveways, crossings

See if you can make one big rubbing of lots of items together such as leaves.

Get people to guess what objects you have used for the rubbings!
