This week Christmas came to Tigers. The children have been working hard to learn the words and actions to our Christmas songs. We have continued with the story 'Abel's Moon' by Shirley Hughes this week. We have challenged the children to make rockets in the modelling area and to draw or paint a Christmas picture with a person in it.

In maths the children have been using 5 frames to show 1 more, 1 less and equal to. They have also been introduced to the signs for addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=). We have been looking at the number bonds to 5 (5+0, 4+1, 3+2, 2+3, 1+4, 0+5) ask your child to show you the number bonds with their bunny ears.

Over the holidays can you please encourage your child to dress and undress themselves and let them practise turning their clothes the right way around. This will make them more independent on our PE days. It is also more important as the weather is much colder, that they can fasten their coats and put on gloves themselves.

This is our last newsletter of the term and we would like to take this opportunity to wish you all a Happy and Safe Christmas.

Our topic in the new year will be 'All Creatures Great and Small'.
