The children have been making lots of different types of vehicles in the modelling area. They have also been using shapes to make pictures of tractors and fire engines. Why not encourage your child to make a vehicle at home? What might they use? Recycled materials, Lego, Duplo or something else.

We looked at how we travel to school and recorded this on a graph, it was good to see how many children are walking or riding their scooter or their bike to school every day.

In maths this week, we have introduced to the concept of 'one more'. The children have been using the number blocks to show one more and played 'My Granny went to Market' which tested not just their ability to add one more, but also their memory.

We still need large t-shirts, plain pillowcases, tights, belts, ties, scarves and pieces of fabric or anything else you may have to develop our deconstructed role-play area to encourage the children to use their imaginations.

Please try to spend some time each day with your child practising their sounds and words. Watch out for new sounds and words to add to your child's keyrings.
