This week our story is 'Six Dinner Sid' by Inga Moore. This is a story about a very cheeky cat who lives in 6 different houses so that he can have six dinners. Ask your child to tell you about the story. See what they can remember. You could watch the story together at home by following the link -

Linked to our story the children have been following instructions to draw cats, they have labelled and coloured their pictures. They have written sentences about how Sid looks and what he did in the story.

In maths we have been looking at number bonds to 5. The children have really enjoyed the 'How Many in my Hand' game. All you need to play is 5 small objects which you can hold in your hands in different ways. For example you might have 2 in one hand and 3 in the other. Ask your child to choose a hand, show them the contents and ask them to tell you how many objects they can see. Can they then tell you how many you have in your other hand with out looking? Try with 5 and 0, 4 and 1, 2 and 3.

We haven't been able to get out to play much this week, but we have had lots of fun and exercise dancing! Your child might like you to join them in a dance at home. Follow the links and have some fun.
