This week we have continued with the story 'The Journey Home from Grampa's' by Jemima Lumley. The children have been making their own journey stories with a beginning a middle and an ending. They have also been challenged to draw around shapes to make a 2D shape vehicle.

We have been looking at the paintings of Piet Mondrian and creating our own pictures by printing lines and filling in some of the shapes created with primary colours.

In maths this week, we have introduced the two dimensional shapes; circle, triangle, rectangle and square. The children have been using the language of shape (side, edge, corner, straight and curved) to name and describe these shapes. Why not encourage your child to look for shapes at home or when you're out for a walk. Go on a shape hunt see how many you can find.

Have a look at the Shape Monsters and Shape Train, we really enjoyed these.
