This week our story is 'Abel's Moon' by Shirley Hughes. This is a lovely story about a family where dad tells the children about his adventures as he travels around working away from home. Ask your child to tell you about the story. See what they can remember.

Linked to the story the children have been designing their own vehicles to travel to the moon and labelling them. They have also been practising their painting skills and painting pictures of vehicles.

In maths this week, we have introduced the three dimensional shapes; sphere, cylinder, cuboid, cube, cone and pyramid. The children have also been using the language of 3D shape (face, edge, vertices, flat and curved) to describe them. Why not encourage your child to look for 3D shapes at home or when you're out for a walk? Can they sort the shapes they find in different ways?
