Dear Parents/Carers,

It is unfortunate that the country yet again requires a National Lockdown. We will however, as a school continue to support our community and our families during this time. From Wednesday 6th January our school will be OPEN to children who are described as vulnerable and keyworker families only.

All other children will receive details regarding Home Learning for the next 6 weeks as soon as possible.

Vulnerable Children

During the course of this morning, school will be in contact directly if your child has been identified as requiring a place in school due to 'vulnerability' such as:

- children who have a Child In Need (CIN) plan, a Child Protection (CP) plan or who are a Looked After Child (LAC previously known as Children In Care)
- children who have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)
- children identified as vulnerable by educational providers or Local Authorities (LA) (including children's social care services), and whom may have a social worker
- children on the edge of receiving support from children's social care services or in the process of being referred to children's services
- · adopted children or children on a special guardianship order
- children in receipt of the Pupil Premium funding

Key Workers

If you feel your child qualifies for a place in school as you are a Key Worker please email leebriggadmin@watertonacademytrust.org and provide full details of your role as a critical worker (evidence may be requested of this status) as well as:

- Details of work which qualifies as critical worker from the headings below:

 - ✓ Food production, distribution, delivery and sales

Please return all emails <u>before 1pm today</u> (5th January 2021). We will contact you as soon as possible after receipt of your email to confirm your place. Key Worker children MUST attend each day as we are not able to operate a rota system.
