Firstly, I would like to thank our staff, parents, carers and pupils for their determination, resilience and patience shown during the most recent period of blended learning. It has truly been a team effort and we have a fantastic team at Lee Brigg!

As you are aware, the government has announced that schools should fully reopen from **Monday 8th March 2021** and the staff at Lee Brigg Infant & Nursery School are excited to welcome all of our children back to school!

The Government has confirmed that attendance will be mandatory (all pupils will be expected to attend); our usual policies will apply, meaning that we will be recording attendance and following up on any absences. Please be assured that we will look to reassure and support families wherever there is a need.
