This week we continued with our book 'Letters around the World'. We read the letter from Muhammad, who lives in Tanzania. We looked at similarities and differences between Muhammad's family and our families, discussed what Muhammad likes to eat and how his life is different from ours. We made books to show what we had learned about Africa.

We used playdough to make African patterns, painted and drew African patterns and made jewellery using different materials.

In maths, we compared quantities. We used the language of more and fewer and used 10 frames to develop our counting and subitising. We looked at books with different quantities to practise using the language of more and fewer.
