This week's learning: Our key text will be 'Mr Wolf's Pancakes'.

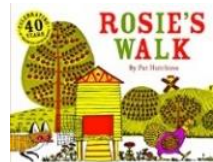
Our number rhyme will be 5 Crispy Pancakes

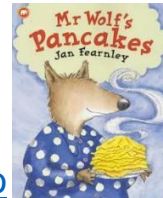
and of course we will make and taste pancakes!
