Our key text will be 'Peace at Last'. We will join in with the repeated refrains from the story and make different voice sounds.

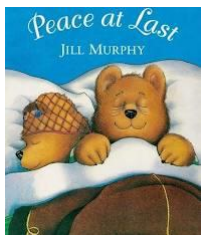
In Letters and Sounds, we will take part in activities to help us to learn about rhyme and we will use our listening skills to follow instructions.
