This week we have been learning all about Easter and Spring. We learnt an Easter poem and a Spring song. We also talked about why we celebrate Easter and how it is an important time for Christians. We discussed how some animals are born in Spring and how flowers start to grow. Why not look out for signs of Spring when you are out and about over the next couple of weeks?

Holiday challenge: peel vegetables safely

Encourage your child to help you in the kitchen by learning to peel vegetables safely. This will help your child learn about keeping safe in the kitchen and will also help develop their fine motor skills and encourage them to persevere.

In maths, we are getting better at knowing which numbers go together to make a given total (number bonds). We used numicon, cups with pebbles and number cards to make 5 and 10 in different ways. We also learnt a dice trick to help us remember our number bonds to 7 – if you have a dice at home – ask them to show you.

We looked at different patterns on animal fur, clothing and in our homes. We learned how to make a repeating pattern, for example – egg, chick, egg, chick, egg, chick etc.. and made Easter headbands with our patterns on.

We watched a story called 'Yellow wants to play with Orange' and discussed how we can all be friends even if we have differences (Eg boys and girls). We enjoyed another music session where we made patterns with our bodies and instruments.
