Dear Parents and Carers,



This week saw the easing of restrictions as part of the Government response to the 'roadmap out of lockdown'. The Government have now eased limits regarding seeing friends and family. This means that some legal restrictions on meeting others outdoors have been lifted - although gatherings of over 30 people outdoors will remain illegal. Indoors, the 'Rule of 6' (or 2 households) now applies.
