In maths, we have been 'doubling' numbers – many of the children can now recall doubles up to double 5 – you could play games with dice or dominoes to practise this at home.

In our creative work this week, we made multi media houses and worked with friends to build or make 3D houses. We retold and /or acted out the story of The 3 Little Pigs.

## **Skills for Life Challenge**

## **Outdoor area**

We are in the process of developing a new outdoor area for the children. We need:

**Den building equipment** - towels, old bed sheets, scarves, ties, pegs, tarpaulin, rope

**Large equipment** - bikes or scooters, sweeping brushes, go-karts, balls

**Role play** - dolls, prams, dolls accessories, dress up clothes, chairs and tables

**Protective gear** - sun hats or caps, sun glasses, umbrellas, woolly hats, gloves, mittens, waterproof clothing, wellies

**Exploration** - sand and water equipment, buckets, paint brushes

**Gardening** – gloves, tools, plant pots, soil, seeds, kneeling mats

or anything else which is suitable for outdoor play.
