This week we will revisit the text **Dinosaur Roar** by Paul and Henrietta Strickland.

Revisiting stories is good for story language, vocabulary, rhythm and pattern and comprehension. Repetitive reading helps children to become confident readers.

The children will take part in our sponsored 'jump up and down' day.

In 'Letters and Sounds' we will continue to look at letter shapes, letter sounds and letter names. (This will be the children who going to school in September). The younger children will continue to take part in activities to help them to develop their listening skills and turn taking skills. We will use the movements down, across, round, up, back up with the flipper flappers and writing/painting tools.

In maths we will use the vocabulary more/less same, different, notice.

Now the weather is getting warmer, can we please ask that you apply sun cream to your child before coming to nursery and that you provide your child with a sun hat (please name it).
