This week we made a 'wanted' poster and used the sentence starters He is, He has and He can to describe the big bad wolf. We worked in groups to make large scale story maps and we added different materials to make them multi media as well as writing to help retell the story.

In maths, we shared quantities fairly. We used objects, pictures or drew our own pictures to help us practise this skill. Can you help your child practise this at home. Can your child tell you which numbers can be shared equally between 2 and which can't?

We have also been scientists and discussed what things are made of – we hunted outside for things made of wood, plastic, metal, glass and clay and discussed what things in our classroom were made of (including fabric). We were also historians and discussed how houses have changed since Victorian times. The children could not believe that most houses did not have bathrooms and that people had to go outside to go to the toilet! Yesterday we discussed 'Clean Air Day' and how vehicles contribute to the levels of pollution. We talked about 'doing our bit' by walking instead of driving when possible.
