2 cups of flour

1 cup of salt

4 teaspoons of cream of tartar

4 tablespoons of oil

2 cups of boiling water

Food colouring.

Mix together until it forms a dough. Keep in an airtight container.

Reminders: Please remember to provide your child with a pair of wellies to keep at nursery and please name all your child's clothing, including footwear. Please ensure that your child brings a coat to nursery every day.
