Our target vocabulary this week: perfect, tall, grumpy, puppy and fierce. Please try and use these words as you go about your daily routines at home.

The children have been busy cutting, drawing and writing their name. You can see their great work in their 'I can book' which is displayed in the book room.

We discuss the weather and days of the week daily. We use our alliterative skills to remember the days of the week. Each day's phrase is displayed on our board in the cloakroom.

At circle time we introduced the children to our 'nose wiping' station. The children are already getting much better at this skill. The children have also enjoyed exploring the 'giant' mouth and teeth. We have talked about how to keep our teeth healthy and we are sure that you will reaffirm this and nose wiping at home!
