Attendance Analysis

We have today sent home your child's attendance for the first half of the autumn term up to and including **Tuesday 19th October 2021**, which gives a detailed breakdown to help you keep track of your child's attendance. The attendance summary is colour coded:

Blue 100%

Well done! The best chance of success. Children get off to a flying start!

Green 95%-99.9%

You are on target or above. You are off to a flying start. The government's good attendance target is 95%

Yellow 90%-94.9%

Worrying. Less chance of success because of periods of lost learning. Below 95% is considered below acceptable by the Department for Education (DfE)

Red Below 89.9%

Serious. Education Welfare Officer Involvement. Your child is considered a persistent absentee. You are now liable to prosecution and a fine if attendance does not improve significantly.

Please speak to the school office in the first instance should you wish to discuss your child's attendance in further detail, or should you have any queries.

Lee Brigg Award - Skills for Life Challenge
