We really enjoyed our Autumn welly walk to the woods on Wednesday. We used our eyes and ears to help us explore our local countryside. We saw and heard animals including insects and birds we also saw trees, plants and bushes, planes, tractors, electricity pylons and shadows. We were very lucky it was a sunny day.

We also enjoyed a visit from a librarian this week. Wendy the Librarian came in and read two super stories; Rumble in the Jungle and Shark in the Park. We really enjoyed listening to the stories and Wendy was very impressed with how well we could sit and listen.

Last week in phonics we learned ck, (when 2 letters make one sound, it is called a digraph) e, u, r and this week we learned h, b, f and l. We have also learned the tricky words 'l', 'is' and 'the'. Hopefully the children will start recognising these words in their reading books as they read with you.

This week our activities have included taking turns with others, making repeating patterns with different objects and materials and practising mixing colours using the dip, dab, dob, mix strategy. We also practised cutting, joining and model making and writing sounds we know in order to label our pictures or as part of our imaginative play.
