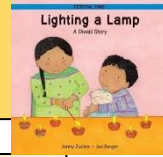


Our value of the term is: Responsibility. We will be responsible for tidying up, looking after our toys in nursery and keeping ourselves and each other safe.

Learn how to become responsible

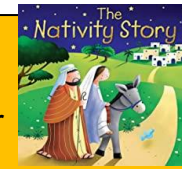
Work cooperatively with one another

Take part in quality conversations.

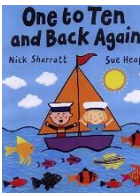
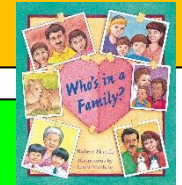
Ask and answer questions.

Explore Numicon tiles.

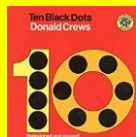
Say number rhymes.

Listen and tune in to different sounds that instruments make.

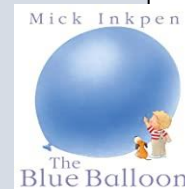
Learn about the Grimethorpe Colliery Band and the artist Piet Mondrian.
