Please try and use these words with your child to help them further develop their language.

We practised cutting, joining and modelling to make Halloween lanterns, pumpkins or monsters and we added white or black paint to change the shade of paint, when painting Autumn leaves.

We enjoyed the weather this week and the rain and the wind did not stop us from playing out. When it was windy, we tried to catch the leaves falling off the trees and used the parachute to play games. When it was raining, we put on our wellies and swept up leaves.

We had a treat this afternoon as we managed to get 20 golden pebbles in our marble jar. We had popcorn or crisps and enjoyed watching a 'movie'. A golden pebble is earned when all children are making good choices. We earned pebbles for all listening or sitting nicely, lining up quietly, all trying hard in phonics or with wake up shake up or for good listening to our talking partners.
