Our target vocabulary this week: collapsed, squashy, grumbled, squealed, cottage, grin and our wow word was 'boomed'. We also revisited the vocabulary we learnt last week. Please try and use these words at home.

In our circle time session, we talked about our teddy bears and enjoyed having a picnic with them. We made our own sandwich and made a label for our bear so that we knew which bear belonged to who.

We have learnt lots of facts about bears, please remember to ask your child what they have learnt.

We have explored different sized bears using the language, big, bigger, small, smaller and copied repeating patterns. If you would to know more about our learning, please ask.
