



Dates for your diary: World Book Day: Thursday 3rd March. The children are invited to come to nursery in their dressing up clothes on this day.

Monday 7th March is Book Swap day. You are invited to accompany your child to The Brigg. Please bring an unwanted book with you (children's or/and adults). You will then spend time with your child looking at the collection of books. Your child will then choose a book they want to take home and swap it for their book. We would like all the children to have the experience of the book swap. All children will need to be accompanied by an adult. If you are unable to attend, a relative or friend can come in your place. Children come to nursery at the normal time and adults will need to return to nursery at 10.30am (if your child attends nursery in the morning) and 2.30pm (for the children who attend nursery in the afternoon).

Tuesday 8th March, you are invited to a parent's meeting at 2.30pm about making sure children have a healthy start to their day. This is a really important subject so please try your best to attend.

We have lots of exciting things planned for next term. We will of course celebrate pancake day and learn about Easter.

You will be invited to our Easter stay and play session where you will spend time making Easter crafts with your child. We will also hold an Easter Parade. The dates and times of these events will be given to you after the holidays.
