



Our value of the term is: Forgiveness. We will discuss this in our circle time sessions.

Seek out others for help.




As communicators, we will:



As readers and writers we will:
Listen to and enjoy the stories shown and many more (daily).
Take part in daily pre-phonics sessions (orally blend and clap syllables).
Retell stories with visual prompts.
Begin to make marks that resemble some letter shapes.
Begin to recognise words that have the same initial sound (orally).

As mathematicians, we will:
Recognise groups of objects without counting (subitise 1-3).
Join in with number rhymes.
Count daily.
Listen to stories.
Link numerals and amounts up to 3.
Use the language of size.
Use subject specific vocabulary (see newsletter and parent's board)



As artists, actors and musicians we will:
Explore paint and learn how to mix colours.
Learn new songs/rhymes and dances.
Design and build cages for animals.
Learn how to use a variety of fastenings such as sellotape, masking tape, stapler.
Take part in food technology activities such as baking a moon cake, tasting Chinese food (Chinese New Year), making porridge and sandwiches.
Act out stories such as The Chinese Zodiac using The Helicopter Story approach.
