Our week started with a delivery from The Little Red Hen! We received bread and vegetables and a letter asking us how long it would take to toast the bread. On Monday, we made toast and covered it with oodles of butter, just like the Little Red Hen. We practised peeling and cutting vegetables and on Wednesday, we made and tasted vegetable soup.

We ordered pictures from the story and wrote sentences to retell the story. We acted out the story and painted pictures of The Little Red Hen, adding other materials to make our pictures multi-media.

In maths, we ordered and sequenced the days of the week and sequenced events in our day. We also explored how many times we could write our name, jump and how many beads we could thread in one minute. Why not try timing your child at home? How fast can your child get dressed? Or how many words can they read in one minute? We also combined groups of objects to work out how many we had **altogether**. Children recorded this with drawings and some were keen to write addition sentences (sums) too!
