This week we read Mr Wolf's pancakes and on Tuesday we were excited to receive a parcel from Mr Wolf. He sent us some pancakes and different toppings to try. Our favourite topping was chocolate spread but we also enjoyed tasting honey, jam and lemon with sugar! Our key words this week are **slamming, bulging, borrow, managed, carried, chorused, pile, drifted, rude(ly) and decided.**

We painted some amazing wolves and then added other materials to make them multi-media. We made split pin characters from the story and made masks too!

In maths, we learned about 3D shapes (**cube, cuboid, cylinder, sphere, cone and pyramid.**) We discussed the **faces** of the shapes and named **rectangles** (any 4 sided shape, including squares and oblongs) **squares, oblongs** (2 long and 2 short sides), **triangles** and **circles**. We discussed whether **faces** were **flat** or **curved** and talked about which shapes could roll and why. We also looked at 9 and 10 and discussed the different ways of making 9 and 10 from smaller numbers.

The children were super excited to dress up for World Book Day – thank you for your support with this! We learned lots of new vocabulary and enjoyed talking about and reading some of our favourite stories.

Thank you to everyone who completed their holiday challenge. It is great to see how many children are able to make their own sandwich – the passports will all be updated.
