



Thank you to everyone who came to our 'Easter stay and play' session. We hope that you enjoyed the session. **This week's learning:** We have learnt about Easter. We used resurrection eggs to help the children to understand the Easter story. These are a set of plastic eggs that have a symbol (inside each egg) that represents a different part of the story such as a cross, a palm leaf, a crown of thorns.

Our key vocabulary was linked to the Easter story and our key words were Jesus, thorns, cross, supper and tomb. Our 'wow word' was celebrate. Please try and use some of these words at home over the Easter holidays.

The children were lucky enough to receive an Easter egg from the Easter Bunny. The children wrote a letter to him asking him to wipe his feet (before he came into nursery). However, he clearly did not read them as there were muddy footprints everywhere!

We also said goodbye to our chicks. Farmer Dean has now taken them back to his allotment.

After the holidays our topic for the half term will be 'Ready Steady Grow'. We will learn how humans, animals and plants change when they grow. We will begin our topic learning about how we have changed from when we were a baby.
