#### IMPORTANT DATES:

**Lotherton Hall trip- Friday July 15<sup>th</sup>.** Payment for the trip will be collected after the half term holiday.

**Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July is 'Shuffle Up Day'.** This is for the children moving to school in September. They will visit their new classroom and meet their new teacher. The children will need to arrive at school at 9.20am (please wait with your child at the door at the front of school) and they will need to be collected at 12.15pm from the same place.
