We had a great time on Tuesday when George from Discovery Kitchen came to visit. We all helped make veggie burgers and a fruit and vegetable smoothie. Thank you to everyone who donated money towards this experience. We have continued to talk about healthy food choices and discussed which food groups we eat and why.

This week we read the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. Our key words are **strange, wrinkly, touches, gloomy, giant, scrambled, picked, whisked, grind** and **demanded**. We drew story maps and used props to retell the story. We wrote descriptive sentences about the beans we planted and some of our beans are growing quickly. Don't forget to email us with the progress of the beans you have at home!

In phonics this week we introduced the tricky words **were, here, little** and **says**. We read words with 5 and 6 phonemes including scrub, grand and scrunch. We will be adding the tricky words to the key rings next week so please keep practising at home!

In maths we used the '**first, now, then**' language to add quantities together. For example: **First** there were 3 children on the bus, **then** 4 more got on. How many are there **now**? See if you can use this language at home to solve number problems too. We also used 3D blocks to build models and to copy pictures.

We heard the story "Blue learns to share" and discussed how we need to share with others as this is important to be able to be a good friend.

We have almost filled our marble jars and so next Friday children will be allowed to bring their pyjamas in a bag as this is the treat they chose.

On the following Friday (27th May), we will hold our sponsored wheelathon. Children will be allowed to bring in a bike or scooter and a helmet (or can borrow one of ours).
