



This week's learning: Our key text was 'The Bumble Bear' (you can listen to the story on you tube)

Our key vocabulary was: worker, drone, queen, hive, pollen, nectar, honey, trampled and hero. Our wow word was 'diabolical'. Please try and use these words at home.

We have learnt lots of facts about bees, learnt how to waggle dance and baked honey biscuits.

At circle time the children talked about what they wanted to get better at doing (a target). The children's targets will be written on a bee and their bee will be placed on a flower (on the wall near the home corner). The children will practise their target and once they achieve it, their bee will fly onto the hive (on the display near the carpet).

IMPORTANT DATES: Monday 4th July is 'Shuffle Up Day'. This is for the children moving to school in September. They will visit their new classroom and meet their new teacher. The children will need to arrive at school at 9.20am (please wait with your child at the entrance at the front of school, NOT the main door to the school office) and they will need to be collected at 12.15pm from the same entrance. The children will have their lunch at school on this day. The children who attend the afternoon session and are moving to school in September will need to come to school in the morning on this day. There will be NO afternoon nursery session for these children on this day. The children who are staying in nursery for another year OR going to a different school come to their normal session at the normal time.
