This week we continued reading 'The 3 Little Pigs'. We wrote descriptive sentences about the wolf and drew the wolf using Colour Magic on the computers and laptops. We drew wolves by drawing around 2D shapes and mixed colours to paint wolves. We worked with a friend to make multi-media scenes from the story and used the small world area to retell the story or to make up our own!

In maths, we used the mobilo to make models; we had to find the right pieces and follow instructions to make a model. We also made some models of our own. We learned how to share fairly (the early stages of division) and the children shared pictures and objects into groups. For example, If you had 6 biscuits, could you share them equally between 2 children? Could you share them equally between 3 children? What if there were 4 children? Please practise at home and use the language '**share equally**' and '**left over**' Please be as creative as you like and send us emails so we can share your ideas with the other children.

We have also been busy making cards for Father's Day and learning to sort materials in different ways. We went on a material hunt and looked for things made from **wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick or stone** and **fabric**. Why not go on a material hunt and see what things are made of at home!

We watched '**Pink's Screen Time**' and discussed how much time we should spend on our screens. We also watched '**Yellow play fights**' and discussed how to play appropriately and the importance of not hurting others.

We enjoyed an exciting visit from the police yesterday. Sargeant Loney (Jessica's Dad) and PC Culpan brought along a police van and equipment. The children learned all about the role of the Police how they keep us safe!

On Thursday 7th July we will be taking the children on a trip to Tropical World. We will travel by coach and the cost will be approximately £12 per child. If you want to pay this in instalments, please pop into to school and see a member of staff. We will send out more details and a permission letter nearer the time!
