If your child is NOT going to be attending the trip on Friday 15th July please remember there will be NO nursery session on this day.

The leavers show will begin at 10.15am. The show will take place outdoors (weather permitting). The children come to nursery at 8.30am and parents/family members are asked to return at 10.10am. After the show, refreshments will be served in the nursery garden.
