This week we read the story 'Harry saves the Ocean' by N.G.K. The story is about pollution and what we can do to look after our planet. Our key words this week are **rubbish, difference, ocean, dumped, saves, strange, harmful, free, rot and plastics**. Please encourage your child to use these words at home. We wrote descriptive sentences about the characters in the story. We also used 'pointillism' (the use of coloured dots to build a picture) to create fish and worked with a friend to make under sea collages.

In maths, we used multilink cubes to make models and also tried to copy a friend's model. We learned about **odd** and **even** numbers. We learned how all odd numbers end in 1,3,5,7 or 9 and how all even numbers end in 2,4,6,8 and 0.

We watched '**Blue's indoor Voice**' and discussed how we need to use a quiet, calm voice when we are inside. We also discussed ways in which we keep ourselves healthy and active. Please remember to send in any **green leaves** (The ones we sent home for when the children are keeping healthy or active). The children love sharing them with each other.

We are hoping to take the children on our Summer walk on Wednesday. We will also be taking litter grabbers and bags so we clean up our local area. Please ensure your child has a sunhat and a coat (just in case).
