The children who are staying in nursery for another year OR are going to a different school need to come to their normal session at the normal time.

Shuffle up day is a very exciting day for the children. We will be there to welcome the children into school (along with their new teachers). We are sure that the children will have a wonderful morning in their new classroom, so please ask them all about their visit.
