We continue to listen and respond to any ways in which you feel that our school could improve. Areas for development for us from the surveys were:

- Parent/Teacher Consultations feel very rushed. I know it's tough with so many children, but 15 mins just does not feel long enough to really go through all topics.
- It is great that you can organise events that engage with parents but it would be better if you could vary the days that these take place (not always Thursdays) and give more notice when they will take place for those who work. Thank you

We will endeavour to plan our calendar for parents next year on a rolling programme so that events / meetings are on different dates. Please do contact us again if this becomes an ongoing issue for you or your family.



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In terms of parent/teacher consultations we too feel that we have a lot to share about your children – but to get through everyone in the class we do need to set time limits for these appointments.

Please however do contact us at any other point in the year if you would like a phone call from your child's class teacher or indeed arrange to see them after school. We will continue to run our 'Learning Journey' events through the year so that you also have these informal opportunities to speak with our staff.
