



DATES FOR YOUR DIARY:

Story time session: You are invited to come and join us at story time on Thursday October 20th. You will have the opportunity to sit and listen to a story with your child and share books with them. If your child attends nursery in the morning, the session will be at 10.45am and if your child attends nursery in the afternoon the session will be at 2.45pm. If your child attends nursery all day, we kindly ask that you attend the morning story time session.

The session will be informative, therefore, please try your best to attend. However, if you are unable to attend, a family member/friend can come in your place. One adult per child.

Parent consultation meetings: Tuesday 18th October and Thursday October 20th. The meetings will be held after school. You will have the opportunity to book a time (nearer the date) to speak with Mrs Windsor.

In preparation for our nursery rhyme challenge on November 10th, we kindly ask that you practise our rhymes of the week at home. This week we have been learning 'Baa, Baa, Black Sheep' and 'Ring a Ring O-Roses' (please see overleaf). Please try and sing these rhymes daily.

This week's learning: Our story was 'Dear Zoo' by Rod Campbell. It is a simple story that introduces the children to adjectives.

Our target vocabulary this week: perfect, tall, grumpy, fierce. Please try and use these words as you go about your daily routines at home.

The children have been busy drawing and writing their name. You can see their great work in their 'I can book' which is displayed in the book room.

In nursery, we discuss the weather and days of the week daily. We use our alliterative skills to remember the days of the week. Each day's phrase is displayed on our board in the cloakroom.

At circle time we introduced the children to our 'nose wiping' station. The children are already getting much better at this skill and we are sure that you will encourage your child to continue to practise this skill at home.

We have shared some of our fabulous learning on Twitter- so please take the time to have a look.

Please remember to read our notice board (in the cloakroom area) to find out what learning the children will be doing each day. On the board, you will find our book and rhyme of the week, along with the vocabulary that we will be learning and our maths activities for the week.

We are in need of empty hand wash bottles please (250ml size). We are going to fill them with paint so that the children can explore colour mixing.
